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HOW YOU STUDY WITH US

- Our program at tertiary level is academically oriented and emphasizes evidence-based learning. Our training program is designed to be multidimensional and includes evidence-based learning. For a holistic understanding of the learning content, we emphasize that cognition (thinking action), thoughts, feelings, emotions, sensations and intuition have an equal status in the learning process.
- To ensure that the knowledge imparted is actively linked to the knowledge content and life experiences already acquired, our focus is on movement-based and experience-oriented learning, including in the theory courses.
- Our curriculum has a circular structure, which leads students into a continuous learning cycle and guarantees that they grasp the complexity of the learning content.

In class, the learning content is continuously linked to existing knowledge and acquired life experience. The lecturers design the lessons to be interactive and development-oriented. Both in class and during the selfstudy time, students are encouraged to develop and deepen their individual strengths and preferences so that they can bring personal expertise to their future work as prospective dance therapists.

- Federal certificate of proficiency (completion of a vocational apprenticeship or basic vocational training) with/without vocational baccalaureate


